



**DESCRIPTION:** Small gabled shed. A single door is centered on the long axis. There are shuttered windows in each of the four walls with additional small windows high on the gable ends. There is a porch roof supported by posts along one side of the shed. The shingle siding is deteriorating, and the shingle roof is moss grown and rotted.
