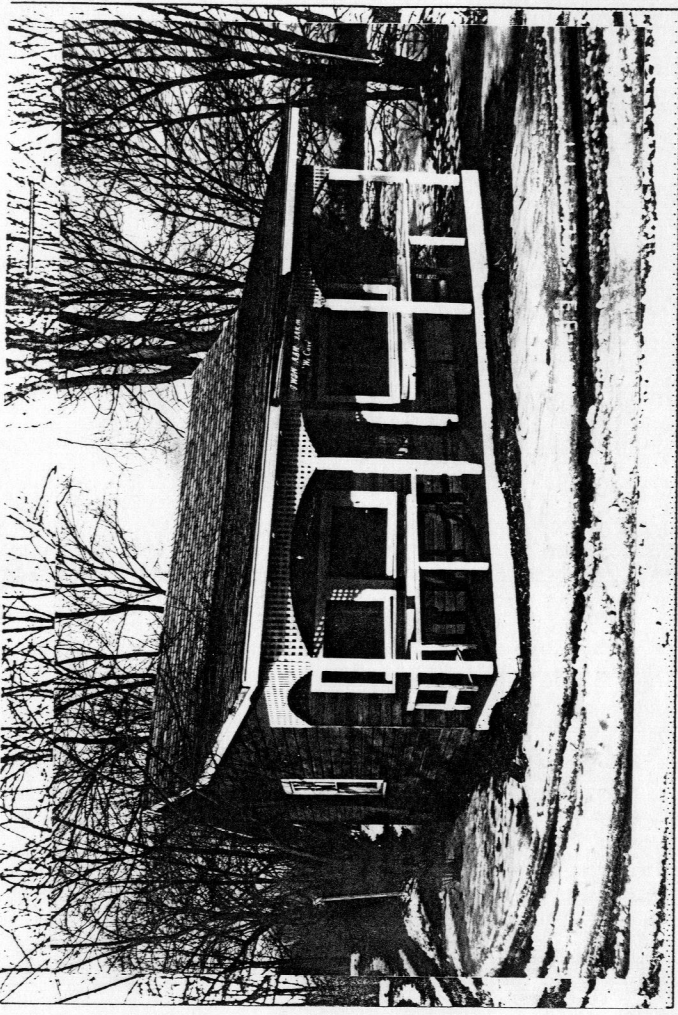

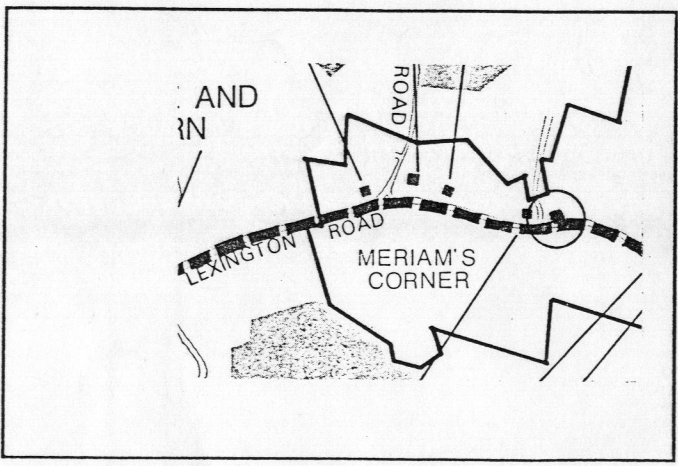

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**HISTORICAL DATA:** Associated with the Albano house and barn.

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**DESCRIPTION:** Gabled one-story structure with full-front porch, weatherboard siding and asphalt shingle roof. The "foundation" consists of a combination of poured concrete and CMU piers. The building is in an advanced state of deterioration.
