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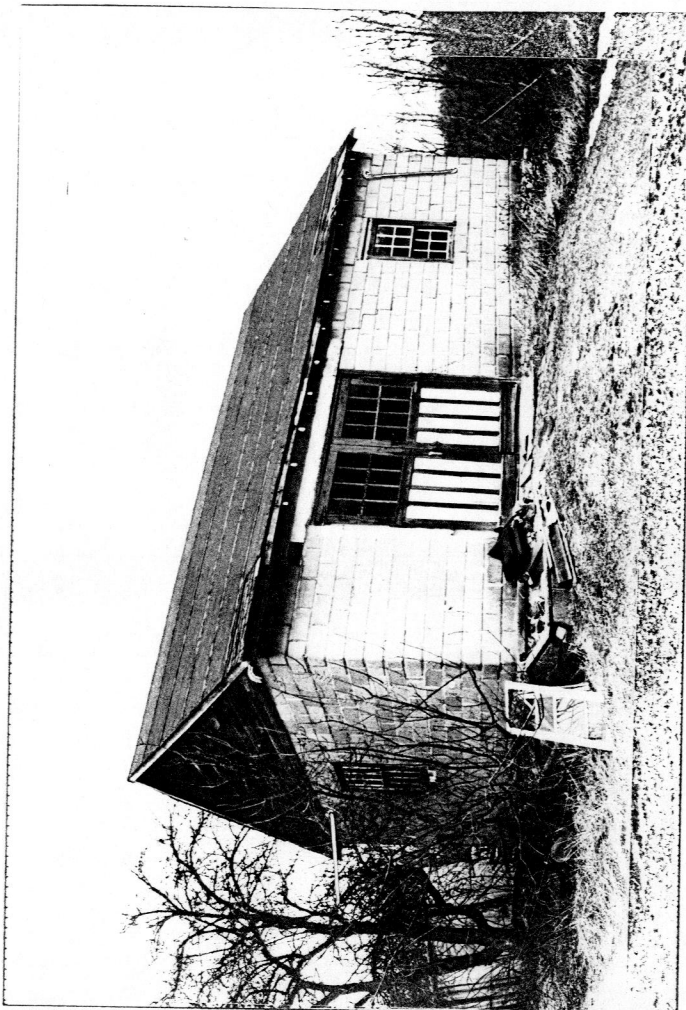

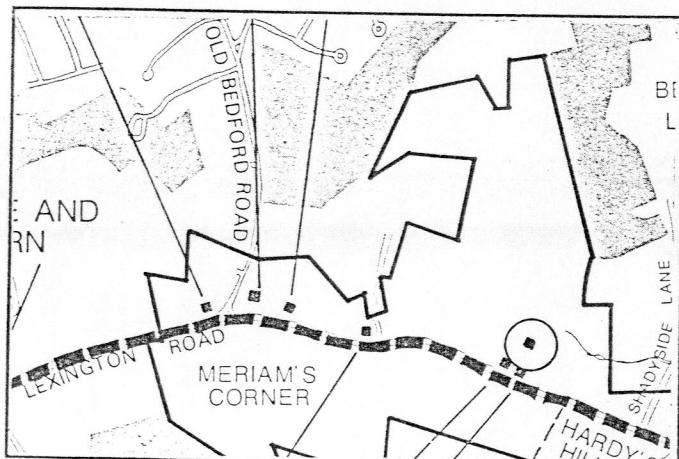

HISTORICAL DATA:

DESCRIPTION: A simple gabled structure. Walls are constructed from large concrete blocks. The walls are penetrated by sash windows and a single set of double doors. The doors are reached by a compact earth ramp. The gable ends of the garage have horizontally oriented wood siding. The roof is asphalt shingle with a coverage of asphalt sheets.
