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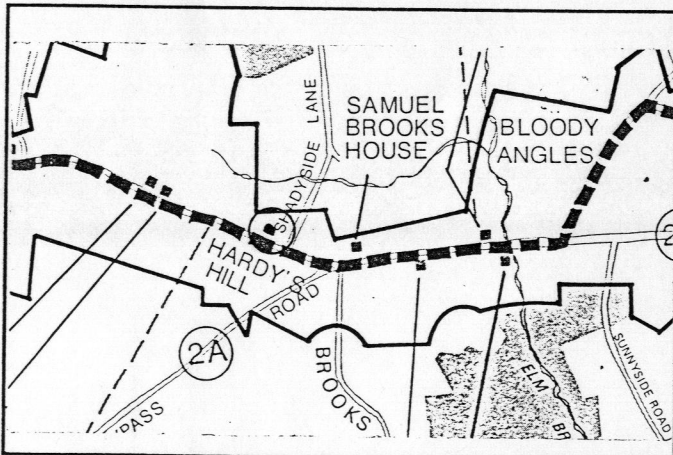
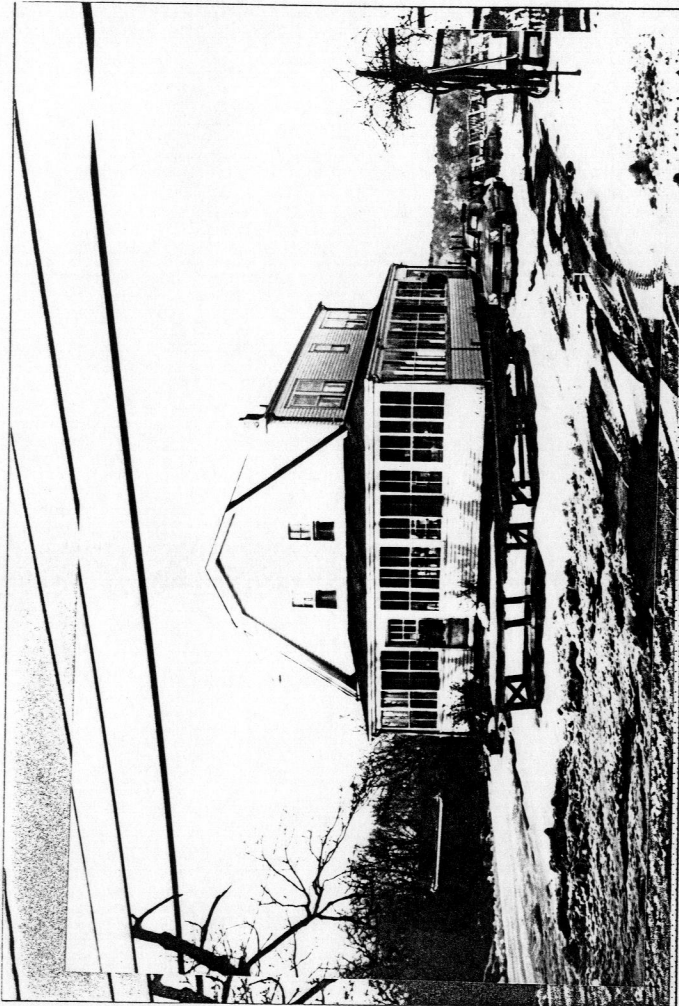

DESCRIPTION: A two-story Dutch Colonial Revival house. Cladding is painted wood siding in a horizontal orientation. The Gambrel roof has two full length dormers. Two sides of the house have a fully enclosed porch. The foundation is made of fieldstone mortared together. The house sits 100' feet from the road and is surrounded by various outbuildings.
